The firearm in the ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor side at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange with the fingers outside the trigger guard. This applies to all firearm ready conditions, unless otherwise specified in the written stage briefing.

The firearm action (bolt) must be closed in all firearm ready conditions.

Carry and Storage - Except when within the boundaries of a Safety Area, or when under the supervision and direct command of a Range Officer, long guns must be unloaded and held, shouldered or slung (or placed in a rack), with the muzzle pointed skywards. Long guns placed in a slip or case are not required to be pointed skywards.

The action may be open or closed, but a chamber safety flag must be fitted at all times when the firearm is not in use. Detachable magazines must be removed.

Rifle must be carried (transported) safely in the bag (gun case) or muzzle up with safety flag inserted.

## On start position rifle bolt must be closed at all times.
